David opened the meeting explaining that the DAC said they wouldn't oppose the previous plan but wouldn't accept it although it was the design they had proposed. There is now a new Church Building Officer who has apologised for all the delays. The position of the toilet has been the main problem.

**New Plan :** Nigel talked us through the new plan. The toilet door will be further from the porch so 2 pews will be taken out of the side to give better access. There will only be one door access into the toilet with easy access for people in wheelchairs. There will be an arch from by the 1<sup>st</sup> pillar in the church to make a porch into the church all filled with glass. David Messer said his preferred option is to use oak for the frame. He suggested asking the art students from Bishop Burton College and/or people from the village to enter designs to reflect the church/village as etchings on the doors. The board which at present is on the wall of the church could be mounted on the toilet wall.

The vote to accept the new plan was unanimous.

Nigel said the new DAC rep acts and replies quickly.

Muriel asked for the windows to be cleaned especially the one behind the altar. It will be incorporated with jobs connected with the building works.
