**Proposal:** Erection of single storey extension to side and rear following removal of existing detached garage

The Parish Council were pleased to note that the extension is single story in nature, and as such it is believed it will not unduly overshadow on the neighbouring property. The Parish Council is however concerned that the removal of the garage and the position of the extension further down the drive may reduce the parking on the property from the current capacity of two cars. It is particularly concerned as parking is already an issue in the village. In view of this the Parish Council **Resolved** to approve the application with the proviso that there is sufficient parking for two cars and that the development remains as a single storey as currently planned to ensure it doesn't overtly overshadow the neighbours.
