

## **To view the planning applications: -**

Plans are available to view on the ERYC website - [www.eastriding.gov.uk](http://www.eastriding.gov.uk).

Once on the site - click “view planning applications” displayed in the central box.

You then get a page headed “view and comment on planning applications” the next

box below it also says “view and comment on planning applications” – click on it,

there then appears a brown/orange button “public access website” click on it, this

brings up 4 steps. Click on “step 4 – Enter Public Access website”, a brown/orange

button “Enter the Public Access website” then appears. Click on it. This will bring

you into the planning website. You will see at the bottom of the page “Planning –

Simple Search” and a few lines underneath it a search bar. If you then type in the

planning application number in the search bar and then press “search” it will take you

to the documents submitted. There were 150 when I looked. But this includes all the

original documents. If you look down the left-hand side you will see the dates

submitted and will be able to identify those since the last application, including the

applicant’s response to the original objections.

## **To submit comments: -**

The **deadline** for comments on the applications is the **8<sup>th</sup> November**. Comments must be either sent to:-

**You must include the planning application reference and your contact details** in all comments submitted.

## **Or submitted on line: -**

To submit on line:- View the planning application as directed above, then, if you have not already commented on any planning applications online you will need to register by pressing the “register” along the top bar. Complete your details. Once completed an email will be sent to you detailing how to activate your account. You will then be able to submit your comments.

If you are submitting your comments directly on line I would suggest that you create a word document on your computer and only when you are happy with it go onto the ERYC planning system and then copy and paste it into the ERYC online system. The reason I say this is that the system times you out after a set period of time and you may lose everything. The system also has a maximum number of words so you may have to submit as an attachment.

**Comments** – ERYC take into consideration all comments submitted. **The more comments the ERYC receive from individual people the more weight they place on the comments. When sending in comments they need to be factual and not emotional.**
