Best Marigold Hotel, The (UK 2011) Cert 12A, 124 mins Genre: Comedy Drama
Director: John Madden. Cast: Bill Nighy, Maggie Smith, Tom Wilkinson, Judy Dench. For a disparate group of English pensioners, retirement takes an unconventional turn when they abandon their homeland, enticed by advertisements for The Best Exotic Marigold Hotel, a seemingly luxurious sanctuary for the elderly and beautiful in Jaipur, India. Tentatively they embark on a new adventure, finding that life can begin again when you let go of the past.

Cast: Brad Lewis, Stars: Owen Wilson, Michael Caine, Joe Mantegna, Star racecar Lightning McQueen and the incomparable tow truck Mater take their friendship to exciting new places in *Cars 2* when they head overseas to compete in the first-ever World Grand Prix to determine the world's fastest car. But the road to the championship is filled with plenty of potholes, detours and hilarious surprises when Mater gets caught up in an intriguing adventure of his own: international espionage. The fast-paced fun includes a

colourful new all-car cast, complete with menacing villains and international racing competitors.

Extremely Loud And Incredibly Close (US 2011) Cert 12, 129 mins

Cast: Tom Hanks, Sandra Bullock Based on the acclaimed novel of the same name, the film tells the story of one young boy's journey from heart-breaking loss to the healing power of self-discovery, set against the backdrop of the tragic events of September 11. Eleven-year-old Oskar Schell is an exceptional child. After finding a mysterious key that belonged to his father, who died in the World Trade Centre on 9/11, he embarks on an exceptional journey. As Oskar roams the city, he encounters a motley assortment of humanity, who are all survivors in their own ways. Ultimately, his journey ends where it began, but with the solace of that most human experience: love.

War Horse (UK 2012) Cert 12A, 146 mins Genre: Drama War

Director: Steven Spielberg. Cast: Emily Watson, Jeremy Irvine, Peter Mullan A tale of loyalty, hope and tenacity set against a sweeping canvas of rural England and Europe during the First World War, *War Horse* begins with the remarkable friendship between a horse named Joey and a young man called Albert, who tames and trains him. When they are forcefully parted, the film follows the extraordinary journey of the horse as he moves through the war, changing and inspiring the lives of all those he meets- British cavalry, German soldiers, and a French farmer and his granddaughter-before the story reaches its emotional climax in the heart of No Man's Land.

The Jay Phelps Quartet

Trumpeter Jay Phelps is at the forefront of the young and creative generation of jazz musicians in the UK, with an instantly recognizable warm and projecting tone. A Vancouver-born Canadian, Jay was tutored by the city's top jazz and classical trumpeters and distinguished himself early on as the youngest band-leader in the Vancouver International Jazz Festival's history. Jay went on to create and co-lead the young and hip jazz sensation Empirical, where he spent two years touring major festivals and events, while garnering worldwide media attention that UK jazz musicians haven't enjoyed for years
