### Parish Council meeting 25 March 2013

- Salt bin on Finkle Street - replaced.
- Dalegate – ERYC work completed excess material used to improve passing places. Road is no longer minor country route as is now used as a cut-through to A1079. Verges being churned up as traffic tries to pass. Clerk to reiterate to ERYC need to formally designate and surface passing places.
- Blocked gullies – Drain on School Green is not draining. Noted drain on snicket from green to church is also not working. Clerk to request permanent solution be found. Two buried grates have been discovered on Joby Lane. Clerk to request ERYC clear these.
- Cottage field – Manhole on-going Yorkshire Water awaiting sleepers.

### Open Meeting of 25 March

- Confirmed on Health & Safety grounds the War Memorial would remain closed except on special occasions
- Requested that Parish Council re-consider whether there are sufficient funds to make a donation to the restoration of the Painting by Walter Goodin donated by Sally McKennie. To be discussed at next Parish Council Meeting.
- Requested the Parish Council re-consider stocking the Mere with fish with any profits being donated to the Playground fund. To be discussed at next Parish Council Meeting.
