

PARISH COUNCIL AND OPEN MEETING NOTES

From Parish Council Meeting 1 July 2013.

- Blocked gullies –awaiting ERYC response (post meeting update – ERYC to connect drain on village green to one outside Woodbridge house)
- Cottage field – Manhole on-going Yorkshire Water.
- Rathlin – site now capped and cleared until results of testing are known – expected autumn.
- Village appearance – area around outside of Joby along Church lane and to be tidied up including removal of self-sown ash trees.
- Dalegate passing places – awaiting ERYC response re traffic survey.
- Planning Application number: 13/01530/PLF. Erection of 4 holiday chalets and creation of new vehicular access onto Dale Gate at Land South of Dalegate Garth Ends Road Bishop Burton East Riding of Yorkshire. Recommend application refused & referred to committee.
- Town & County Planning Act 1990. Description: Fell one Eucalyptus tree in order to place a shed at the bottom of the garden as this is the only level ground in the garden. Location: 22 Callas, Bishop Burton. Applicant: Mr Daniel Cox. Resolved: No observations – unanimous.
- Parish minutes- agreed notes to be published, when possible, on website withn14 days of meeting. Minutes once approved to be published on website and village magazine.
