Resolved: It was unanimously agreed that a response should be sent to the Planning Inspector the main points should be: strength of feeling in the village; effect on the vista – dominant position and size, noise; industrialisation of the environment; East Yorkshire already has sufficient. a) Police Community meeting – Thursday 5th Feb 7pm, Beverley Police Station. Due to short notice no-one is available to attend. **Resolved:** Clerk to respond to this effect.

b) Killingwoldgrave roundabout – essential resurfacing work to take place commencing 23 March. Night working between 8pm and 6am is required. Work is expected to last 5-6days. A1035 York Road, Dog Kennel Lane and Killingwoldgraves Lane will be closed for the duration of the works to through traffic, access to properties will be maintained. The A1079 York- Hull Road will remain open at all times.

c) Manhole opposite Altisidora. Yorkshire Water have been out and have confirmed they will replace the manhole. They are awaiting the part. Note the manhole further along the A1079 is now making a noise. **Resolved:** Clerk to report the new manhole and to further chase the original one.

d) Dalegate Ditch. Landowner has met with ERYC and it has been agreed that ERYC will dig the ditch if BBPC remove the spoil. State of the ditch makes this urgent. **Resolved:** Clerk to chase ERYC re timing.
