The Planning Inspector has dismissed the following appeal:

08.843 Bishop Burton War Memorial – Historic England is considering Bishop Burton War Memorial for addition to the list of buildings of Special Architectural or Historic interest. A report has been received for comment. **Resolved** no comments on the report.

It has been confirmed that listing will not require the memorial to be open. It can continue to be available on special occasions. It was noted that “the government is committed to the nations memorials being in a good state of repair by 2018. **Resolved:** Clerk to liaise with B.Woodward who is kindly looking after the memorial at the moment for any comments he may have and to write to Historic England to understand if they are able to carry out an assessment of the state of repair and whether they could offer any help in bringing it to the required standard.

08.844 Any other business

- a) Painting of railings around the Mere. It had been hoped that this could be carried out by villagers whilst the traffic management (TM) is in place along the A1079 for resurfacing/drainage work. ERYC have advised it would be preferable if the Parish Council had a TM permit in its own right. ERYC have agreed to arrange and pay for the permit. Risk Assessment is required. **Resolved:** To contract M.Gray to do the work (est labour cost £720.). Villagers to help if available. Clerk to contact ERYC to arrange TM. Permit and advise Cllr Gray. **Resolved:** Cllr Wray to do the risk assessment, Clerk to supply template.
- b) BBEG – A number of villagers have commented on the fact that there was no Hog Roast this year. **Resolved:** Chairman to write to chair of BBEG to enquire on whether the organisation had any future plans.
